CTAF: 122.8, Pattern Altitude: 1200 MSL, Left traffic Rnwy 18, Right traffic Rnwy 36.

### Driving Directions to Conner's Hangar:

From Little Rock: Take I40 east to exit 169, Remington exit (approx. 15 miles from McCain Mall). After exiting, turn left (North) at the exit stop sign. Travel approx. ¼ mile, (Note the pond to the left and the Baptist Church directly ahead. Turn to the left (actually straight and to the left of the church) before entering the sweeping right hand curve. Turn left at Carson Bridge Rd (West at the "T" intersection). Travel approx. ½ mile and turn right (North) onto Lingo Rd. Travel approx. 8/10 mile and turn onto 92<sup>nd</sup> West and follow it to the end just before Kitty Hawk Lane. Lee's hangar is on the corner of 92<sup>nd</sup> West and Kitty Hawk Lane.
